
TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

and

Bunker Hill Community College

Associate in Arts: Music Concentration

Salem State University and Bunker Hill Community College, in recognition of a valuable and barrier free public academic experience, have created a transfer articulation agreement between the Bachelor of Arts in Music program at Salem State University and the Associate in Arts Music Concentration program at Bunker Hill Community College.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To encourage the transfer of qualified students from Bunker Hill Community College to Salem State University.
- 2. To award academic credit for courses completed at Bunker Hill Community College that meet the terms of the Associate in Arts Music Concentration program, for application toward the requirements of the Bachelor of Arts in Music program at Salem State University.
- 3. To provide effective and concise guidelines for students seeking to transfer to Salem State University. Students will have accurate and clear information regarding the transfer and applicability of their coursework and credits toward the Bachelor's Degree at Salem State University.

TERMS OF THE TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT:

- 1. Salem State University guarantees the acceptance of students who have completed the Associate in Arts Music Concentration at Bunker Hill Community College with an overall GPA of 2.5 or better, and who have successfully auditioned, to the Bachelor of Arts in Music program at Salem State University. All prospective music majors must audition to be considered for entrance into the Bachelor of Arts in Music program. An in-person audition is strongly recommended, and will be recorded by the music and dance department. - 2. Salem State University guarantees the transfer of credit as stipulated in the attached Program of Studies. This agreement assumes the completion of the Associate Degree and completion of the courses listed on the Program of Studies.
- **3.** A minimum total of 120 credits must be completed to earn a Bachelor of Arts in Music at Salem State University.
- 4. No more than 68 credits will transfer from a two-year institution, or any combination thereof, to Salem State University.
- 5. Bunker Hill Community College transfer students will be subject to all general education requirements of Salem State University as set forth in the Salem State University catalog. Whenever and wherever appropriate, the requirements of the Commonwealth Transfer Compact and / or Mass Transfer will be honored.
- This document is based upon the faculty evaluation of course descriptions presented to Salem State University. Courses as listed in this agreement, with specific exceptions as listed, will transfer to Salem State University provided a grade of 'C-' or better has been earned. The exceptions are:

 MUS101 (equivalent to Salem course MUS120), MUS105 (equivalent to Salem course MUS132N and MUS122), whereby a grade of C is required in order to progress to the next courses in the sequence.
- 7. This agreement shall remain in effect for a period of three years from the date listed below, with the provision that the terms specified herein will continue to apply to students admitted from Bunker Hill Community College's Associate in Arts Music Concentration program within one year of the expiration of the agreement. Each institution agrees to provide timely notice to the other in the event of any modification to the curriculum that might affect compatibility for admission and transfer of coursework. Students admitted to the Bunker Hill Community College Associate in Arts Music Concentration program prior to such notification shall be admitted to Salem State University on the basis of this agreement.
