Transfer Articulation Agreement between Bunker Hill Community College and Suffolk University for the Associate of Arts degree in Psychology to the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology.

Date Established: Spring 2010, Updated Fall 2021

Eligibility:

- 1. Students must complete the Associate of Arts degree in Psychology at BHCC with an overall grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- 2. Students should complete the Suffolk University Guaranteed Admissions Application.
- 3. Students do not need to submit an essay or application fee.
- 4. Students completing the <u>MassTransfer General Education Foundation</u> courses will have already met Suffolk's general education requirements.
- 5. Students completing an Associate's degree with a final GPA of 3.0 or higher are guaranteed a Dean's Scholarship or University Achievement Grant of at least 33 percent off Suffolk tuition (a minimum of \$15,000).
